We invite you to participate in the International Online Olympiad of Students (Bachelors, Masters and Clinical Residents) of Medical Universities "**Samarkand - 2020**", which will be held on 11-12 December 2020.

The International Online Olympiad of Medical Students "**Samarkand - 2020**" is an educational event aimed at popularization of knowledge in various areas of medicine, as well as fundamental sciences, increasing interest in academic activities and science, creating opportunities for students to express their scientific and creative potential.

#### ***The objectives of the Olympiad are:***

1. to improve the level of knowledge of students in medical disciplines;
2. to develop skills and abilities in practical medicine;
3. use of the gained knowledge, skills and abilities by students during the analysis of clinical cases ;
4. to familiarise students of medical universities with the heritage of world and national medicine for the benefit of the people.

**The language of the Olympiad is Uzbek, Russian and English.**

To participate in the Olympiad, you must register on the website [olymp.sammi.uz](http://olymp.sammi.uz) by **December 2, 2020**.

The solemn opening of the International Online Olympiad "**Samarkand - 2020**" will take place **on 11 December at 11:00**.

## ***Participants in the Olympiad***

Students (Bachelors, Masters and Clinical Residents) from medical universities are invited to participate in the Olympiad according to their specialisation and course of study. One participant may choose only one academic discipline.

The Olympiad is held in 4 stages: team greetings (video), a competition for youth scientific projects, competitions in the subjects of directions and a creative competition.

### ***1. "Team greeting"***

The team presents a presentation of their university (faculty) in the city - in a video clip. Rules of Procedure: 5 minutes. The video in mp4 or wmv format must be sent by e-mail (sammi\_yosh@inbox.ru) by 7 December 2020. (file subject: "Video" - "Team welcome")

### **2. "Youth Scientific Projects Competition"**

Forms of participation in the competition: a presentation on the ZOOM platform. Presentation and discussion of the results of students' research work. Reports in MS PowerPoint, please send by 7 December 2020 in electronic form to sammi\_yosh@inbox.ru (file subject: "Olympiad - Science Project").

Regulations: up to 5 minutes.

### **3. Competitions on subjects of referral (tests, clinical tasks, questions)**

The first stage (60 min) consists of solving 60 test questions, 50 of which are subject test questions and 10 questions in a foreign language: English, German and French (depending on the participant's application).

The second stage (5-7 min) for the participants of the Fundamental Disciplines Olympiad will be held by way of answers to the questions in tickets, for the participants of the Clinical Disciplines Olympiad - by way of solving a clinical problem. The student must answer the task clearly and specifically in the ZOOM platform.

### **4. Competition on creativity**

Presentations or videos on the topic: "I am a medical student" are accepted. Presentations, videoclips and photo reports of your creative work are accepted for the creative competition.

Rules: 3-5 minutes.

The competition is held in three categories: "Video", "Presentation-Story" and "Interview".

The responses of the participants will be evaluated by an international jury. It is envisaged to determine the winner and medalists of the Olympiad by the total number of points scored.

The winners of the Olympiad will be awarded diplomas, and participants will receive certificates from the Organising Committee of the Samarkand State Medical Institute. The Organizing Committee of the Olympiad reserves the right to make no significant changes to the programme of the Olympiad.

The closing of the International Online Olympiad "**Samarkand - 2020**" is scheduled for **December 12 at 14:00**, where the winners will be awarded by the Rector of the Samarkand State Medical Institute, Professor J.A. Rizaev.
